The **Royal Garden Swing Orchestra** is made up of professional musicians from the San Luis Obispo County area and is celebrating its 29th year performing the swinging sounds of the Big Band Era. With a musicality rarely heard today, this nine-piece band sounds bigger than the average big band. One newspaper reviewer stated, "This is an orchestra that harkens back to a bygone era when musicians wore tuxedos and had an air of elegance about them. They are true professionals who really understand group synergy. Royal Garden is a favorite dance band for all ages.

The intermission band is the **Gipsy All Stars**, danceable gypsy jazz. This popular band of younger musicians specializes in the music of Brazilian Guitarist Django Reinhardt, Musicians: Laurel Mitchell (vocals), Allan Dick (violin), James Gallardo (upright Bass), Ben Arthur and Toan Chau (guitars).
