*We brought in some new bands this year including "High Street" from Idaho and "Crescent Katz" from Sacramento as well as the hugely popular "Tom Rigney & Flambeau"!*

*This year, we have also hired a headline act, Maria Muldaur with her Jazz Quintet! Maria Muldaur is best known world-wide for her 1974 mega-hit "Midnight at the Oasis," which received several Grammy nominations. Despite her considerable pop music success, her 52-year career could best be described a long and adventurous odyssey through the various forms of American Roots Music.*

*In the 42 years since "Midnight at the Oasis," Maria has toured extensively worldwide and has recorded 40 solo albums covering all kinds of American Roots Music, including Jazz and Big Band, Blues, Gospel, R&B. Often joining forces with some of the top names in the business, Maria has recorded and produced on-average an album per year, several of which have been nominated for Grammy and other awards. For our Jubilee festival, she has assembled some of the best traditional jazz musicians in California, and we know that she will "Bring It" to our ample festival table!*

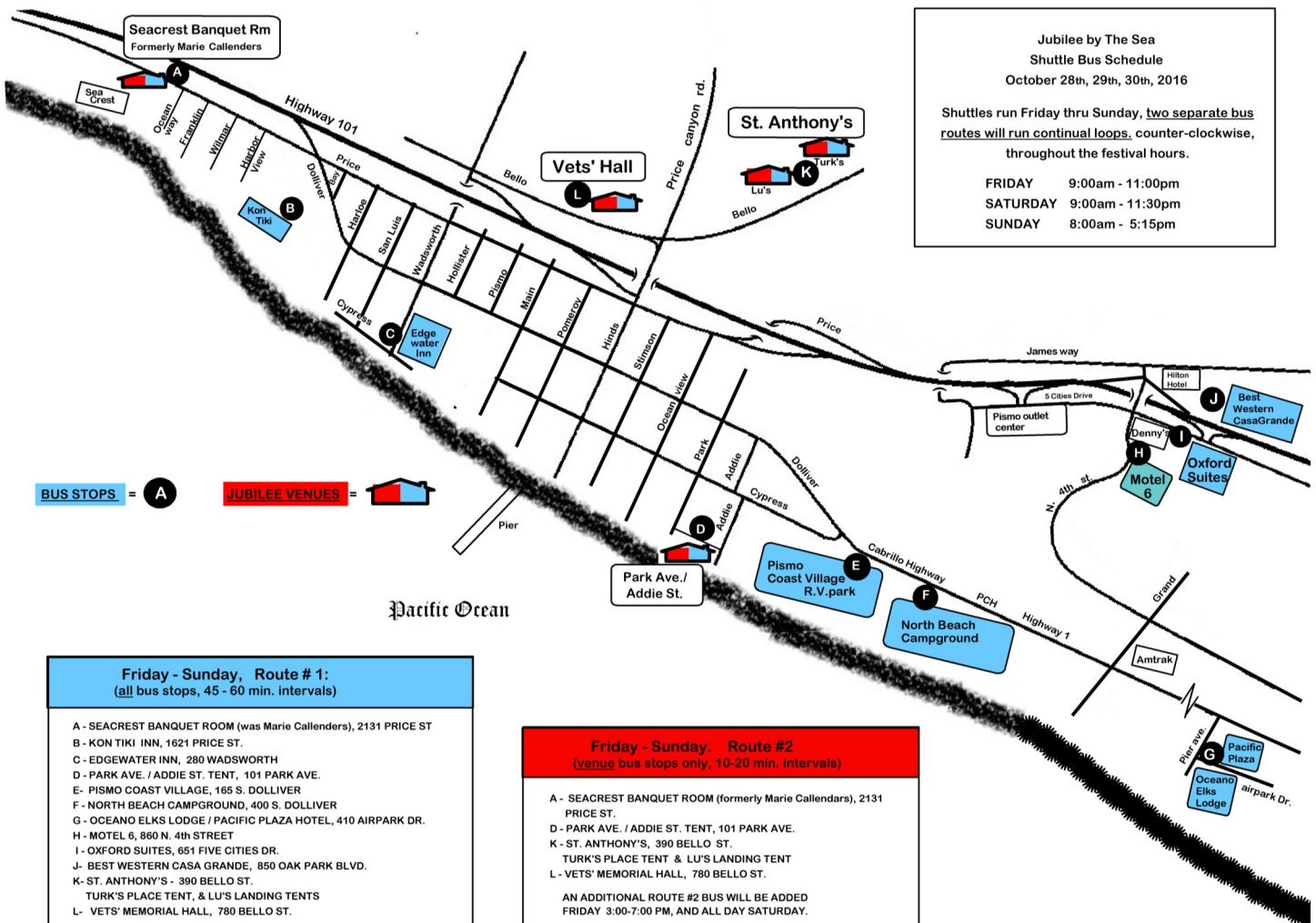
