November was Easy!

Technical Report by Rhonda Cardinal

For the November show, we ran some classic vintage videos- recordings of Viper Six and the Reynolds Brothers. While this show did not require any setup in the back yard, there was still quite a bit of advance work to do.

First, I had to decide which videos to air. These recordings were made between 2010 and 2015 by Jeff from the back of the Vet's Hall. Some came out better than others. The sound for all of them came directly from the mixing board.

After reviewing many candidates, I settled on the Viper Six recording and a recording of the Reynolds Brothers for reasons I described in the November issue.

I uploaded the videos into the Dropbox folder we share with Valerie and Simon Mercado (Noble Productions). Some of the individual cuts had to be strung together by Simon. I then had to record intros for each video using our camera. Jeff helped me with

this. The intros were also uploaded.

After about a week, Simon created a draft of the show and sent me a link for me to view it. I noticed that the aspect ratio for the Reynolds Brothers segment was not correct, and Simon was able to fix that.

The show was ready to run at it's assigned time and went without a hitch. I enjoyed my Sunday off by camping with my family at Santa Margarita KOA. I know that a video show does not have the draw of a live show, but I feel that it is good to remind us of what it was like to have a live band and a full hall at our home in Pismo. It gives a goal to point toward.
