Lizzy from Lizzy and the Triggermen

Lizzy Shapiro is the lead singer/songwriter of Lizzy & the Triggermen, dubbed "10-piece jazz sensations" by LA Weekly and "one of the hottest swing bands in LA" by Good Day LA. Made up of a dream team of trad jazz musicians, and helmed by the inimitable Dan Barrett, their debut album, "Good Songs for Bad Times," hit #3 on iTunes' Jazz charts last year, and they've headlined some of the top venues in LA (the Wiltern, the El Rey, and the Troubadour).

An award-winning classically-trained singer, Lizzy's signature vocals offer a fresh interpretation of jazz standards, which get to shine in the intimate setting of her combo. Inspired by the small groups of the 1930s, The Little Lizzy Combo is made up of some of the same top-notch players from her big band and explores a range of tunes, from beloved standards to rarely-performed gems. She is excited to be bringing a killer line-up for the May 23rd show: Dan Barrett (trombone), Nate Ketner (reeds), Sam Rocha (bass), Gareth Price (drums), Jason Wanner (piano). The show will be Livestreamed from the Cardinal gazebo on Sunday, May 23rd, beginning at 2:00 p.m.

The band took a 15-minute break, and when they came back the troubles began. Bad noises started coming out of Sonny's PA monitor. Sonny unplugged it. Jeff brought out a new monitor. More bad noises. Jeff changed the wire. He changed the microphone. Finally, we removed it from the circuit and Sonny didn't have a vocal monitor for the rest of the show. We let the show run a little long because the band was interrupted for about 10 minutes.

What happened? We are not sure. Jeff suspects his amp and wants to buy a new one, but the one he wants is out of stock and they don't expect any in until June. So he will use another one of his amps for the May show, Lizzy and the Triggersmen. Hopefully, all will go well, but you never know.

Dear Jazz Lovers,

Jazz Jubilee by the Sea 2021 is on track for a fantastic festival October 21–24, 2021 (the 4th weekend of the month). Your favorite bands are excited to come to Pismo Beach and Grover Beach to play for their jazz-starved friends at the planned indoor, *live* Jubilee. Right now things look very good for an enjoyable festival, but if a change must be made, the 2021 livestream event will be bigger and better than last year's. Plus, the livestream will be available whether or not the Jubilee is held in person, and videos will be online for viewing later so that you can catch a performance you missed or relive some of the highlights.

Please see the adjacent form for our current list of Bands and Guest Artists, Donor Levels and Benefits, and Badge Purchase Options. Like in years past, special musical guests will join each of our jam sessions ably led by C.J. Sams. We also will have dance lessons Friday morning at the Veteran's Hall as we have before.

As you know, the all-volunteer Jubilee committee cannot provide jazz camp scholarships or produce such an extensive Jubilee without your help. Your donation is needed **now** to help support our bands, jazz camp scholarships, and the future of our festival.

New venues are in Grover Beach, next door to Pismo Beach. We will be using the Grover Beach Community Center and the Ramona Park facility. Both of these facilities have great features, are close to Pismo Beach, and can be accessed via the surface streets without getting on the freeway. SLO Safe Ride will transport attendees between venues. Parking is limited at most venues, so stay tuned for a list of preferred parking areas for festival goers.

People who can't attend in person can purchase access to watch the livestream performances or access is included for donors over \$50. Livestreams will be broadcast from one venue (to be determined later). As mentioned before, attendees can catch a band they might have missed, or enjoy a repeat performance of a favorite.

If we are forced to cancel the live in-person festival, all monies, including donations, will be refunded without a fee. Please note that we would still be grateful for donations, since the bands will still be performing!

This was their first BSR appearance.

The first set started off with "Mission to Moscow". Dave sang, "My Walking Stick," then Sonny gave us some boogie with, "Pickford Pete." Dave had us shimmying to "Livin' in a Great Big Way," and we would have danced, but that is not allowed. I did spy our regular dancers, check to check, measuring the patio and sidewalk while the band played, "Singin' the Blues." Both the in-house and online crowds went crazy when Sonny sang about, "Margie." After that they did a Bing Crosby tune, "I Don't Stand a Ghost of a Chance with You." Dave and Marc sang "The Music Goes Round and Around," which was so funny. The set finished with "Riverboat Shuffle."

The second set started with, "Doin' the New London Lowdown," and "Love is Just

Around the Corner." Sonny did an original, "I Don't Love You any More, I Don't Love You Any Less." and Dave sang "I Don't Want to Make History."

There were some technical difficulties, but our sound crew got it fixed. We thank Jeff Cardinal, Jim Borland and Fernie Monreal for all they do. The dancers were strutting with "Miss Lizzie." The set ended with, "I Hope Gabriel Likes My Music." The crowd wanted more so they played "San Antonio Rose". A great day of music and fortunately no rain.
