This year's festival will take place from October 17th to October 26th, 2025, featuring a mix of free and paid live music events across California's Central Coast.

This multi-venue, area-wide "à la carte" festival runs from Wednesday, October 15th through Sunday, October 26th, 2025. Once again, the festival will be "orchestrated" by the Basin Street Regulars Hot Jazz Club. It unites this veteran club with other jazz organizations and venues across the Central Coast, with a rich and diverse jazz audience and many active dance groups. Festival Organizers want to highlight all the jazz our area has to offer!

Thursday, October 23rd - Carl Sonny Leyland's Boogie Woogie Piano with Marc Caparone, a specialist in Pre-Bebop Jazz Trumpet, at Puffer's of Pismo, 781 Price St, Pismo Beach. A limited number of advance tics are available. See page 3 for the link for ticket purchase. 7:00 PM (doors open at 6:00). This show will sell out.

Carl Sonny Leyland is internationally known for his mastery of traditional jazz and swing piano, bringing passion, precision, and an undeniable groove to every performance. His ability to move seamlessly from spirited swing to soulful ballads makes him one of the most exciting pianists performing today.



Adding to the night's brilliance is **Marc Caparone**, a specialist in pre-bebop jazz trumpet who has been dedicated to

preserving the traditions of the 1920s and '30s jazz greats. Marc has performed with world-renowned groups including Hal Smith's Rhythm Makers with Rebecca Kilgore, Clint Baker's New Orleans Jazz Band, and the High Sierra Jazz Band, as well as with blues legends Little Charlie Baty and Duke Robillard. In 2022, Marc was honored with induction into the Western Swing Society Hall of Fame.



Together, Carl Sonny Leyland and Marc Caparone will light up Puffers with a night of hot jazz, rich history, and unstoppable rhythm.

The band features Craig Sharmat and Ray Bergstrom on guitar, Kim Collins on bass, and Frank Petrilli on accordion. An Idiomatiqués show is filled with great musicianship, diverse programming, and humor.

Mariachi Autlence was founded by band leader Pablo Martinez. He had always wanted a band, and in 2012 he took action. First on board were his brother and son, but more family members joined along the way and now there are 9 members. Pablo's taste is eclectic. Besides traditional Mariachi music, he dabbles in



other genres including bluegrass and show tunes. Their high level of musicianship and talent are not an accident. They rehearse twice a week and play most Friday nights at

the Maya Restaurant in Santa Maria. It's a pleasure to welcome Mariachi Autlence one again to our Jubilee, an expansion from Traditional Jazz

Bruce Forman is widely regarded as one of the top jazz guitarists in the world today. He has appeared at the Monterey Jazz



Festival over 20 times. Along with a hectic touring schedule, Bruce has 18 recordings as a leader and countless sideman recordings (with Ray Brown, Bobby Hutcherson, Richie Cole, etc). Saxophonist Ron McCarley is the Director of Jazz Studies at Cuesta College where he teaches jazz improvisation and music theory. Additionally, he supervises numerous combos and jazz ensembles, many of which have gone on to win national awards.

Sunday, October 19th, 3:00-4:30 PM, Friendly Neighborhood Big Band at the First United Methodist Church of Arroyo Grande at 275 N. Halcyon Road. The Friendly Neighborhood Big Band is a 16-member big band formed in March, 2019. Members of the band reside in San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara counties. They have been providing audiences with performances of great jazz standards as well as original jazz tunes. They have access to over 2,000 songs of various composers and arrangers. The band has performed concerts at/for a 4th of July Celebration of a Nation in Grover Beach, Livestream for Basin Street Regulars Society Central Coast, And many others.

Madonna Road in SLO. 6:00 to 9:00 PM. Same band, time and place on Sunday, October 26th. Jeff Elliott – the trumpet leader – has had “jazz is in my

veins” since his father, clearly a wise man, bought him a real trumpet in 1963. Back in the 1960s, Jeff’s father made sure Jeff heard the records of Chet Baker, Miles Davis, Stan Getz, Jonah Jones, the high standard bearers and blowers of jazz then. In high school, he dreamed of being a rock star, even if the school sat him in its orchestra’s first chair, as first trumpet. As Jeff matured, playing with his and other bands and appearing night after night with West Coast clubs out on the Pacific shores, his ears began to hear a fresh style of music. That style is not to be put in words here. It is best defined in your ears.

Many jazz aficionados know Gaile Gillaspie’s history with Rare Silk, the 1980s Grammy-nominated vocal group. They recorded three albums. The first album “New Weave,” was nominated for two Grammys, and there was a third nomination for the second album, “American Eyes.” Their last album was called “Black and Blue.” Gaile has since relocated to the Central Coast and has been appearing locally with her Big City Jazz Band as well as being a guest vocalist with other local bands such as the Friendly Neighborhood Big Band. The Big City Jazz Band features local jazz artists drummer Darrell Voss, bassist Ken



Hustad, pianist Rebecca McClafflin, and Grammy winner saxophonist Scott Martin. Gaile’s Big City Jazz performs regularly at Adelina’s at Trilogy and also appears at Paso Robles Jazz

Having played drums and keys for artists around the country, Leader Gerald Purify decided to take these elements along with other world class musicians, to then form The Groove Collective in January of 2024. The Groove Collective focuses on R&B, Soul, and Funk music. The Groove Collective can be seen up and down the coast spreading their message of love and romance, singing catchy hooks, and groovy melodies.

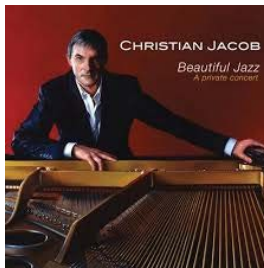

Our vocalists are Mitch Latting and Kathryn Loomis.

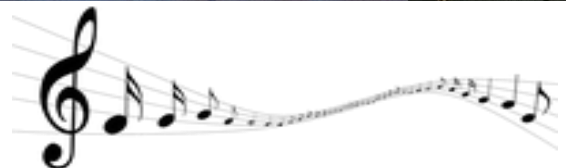
Intermission Band: Early Riser Jazz Combo
