- Tell us about your experience in playing jazz (solo or with a group). This may be demonstrated in one of the following ways:
 - ✓ Attending at least one of the Basin Street Regulars Sunday sessions, sitting in with the jammers.
 - ✓ Performing in a jazz event in your local area or school.
