Cuesta Scholarships by Jon Mounts

The Teagarden Jazz Camp application period ended on April 15th and they will be announcing acceptances very soon. We (BSR) had 14 applications for scholarships, all from motivated and qualified students. We expect all applicants from our club to be accepted.

Cuesta College Community Services is sponsoring a Summer Jazz Workshop July 6-10 and is open to anyone 13 years and older. This is an excellent opportunity for local students and I have reached out to local music educators and booster clubs advising them of our scholarship opportunities. The cost of the workshop is \$200 if registered before May 31 and \$300 after. As there is still funding available from the budgeted \$20,000, I am hoping local students will take advantage of Cuesta's workshop lead by Ron McCarley. The BSR board will support these young musicians via scholarship. The band's colorful repertoire of French and English jazz has built an audience among many swing dance communities. They have performed at numerous clubs, private events, house concerts, and festivals like Jazz Bash by the Bay in Monterey, Hot Jazz Jubilee in Sacramento, the Django Birthday Festival in Berkeley, and the Dixieland Sounds of Mardi Gras in Fresno.

With five albums under their belt, including a Christmas record, the Quartet just released a new album with twelve original songs "San Lyon and Friends".
